Tip: Be sure to make photocopies before cutting if you would like to make more than one crown.

#### **Supplies Needed:**

Construction paper or card stock (thicker paper makes sturdier crowns!) Stapler/glue Markers, crayons, colored pencils, feathers, pom poms, glitter—get creative! Scissors, and a grown–up to help

#### **Directions:**

With the help of a grown-up, cut out the crown template below along the dotted lines. Trace both parts of the template onto a piece of card stock or construction paper—you will need two halves of the crown to fit it around your head.

Have a grown–up help cut out the crown.

Decorate your crown!

Have a grown up help staple or glue the two parts of the crown together so they form a circle, and go rule your kingdom.
