## **HOST A STORYTIME!**

#### **EVENT SUGGESTIONS**

- Set out snacks for the kids. Llama recommends CAKE. Cupcakes or cake pops would also suffice.
- Encourage kids to come in their dancing pants—pajama bottoms will do!
- Hide a "black hole" somewhere in the kids section. Ask the kids to look for it for the chance to win a special prize or to play the part of Llama in the read aloud.
- · Have a dance party and teach the kids how to do their own "cha cha real smooth."
- Make copies of the activities in this booklet and provide markers or crayons.







#### **READ-ALOUD TIPS**

- Use a serious voice for the narrator. Ask one person to read Llama's part to maximize comic effect.
- Llama is a very accomplished artist, dancer, reader, scientist, and general thinker. Ask kids which llama activity is their favorite and what else he should add to his repertoire.
- · Llama makes a few mistakes in the book. Talk to the storytime group about how it's okay to make mistakes.











## MAKE YOUR OWN LLAMA!


AFTER THE READ-ALOUD. FOLLOW THESE EASY STEPS TO MAKE LLAMA DOLLS WITH THE KIDS.

- · Using safety scissors or with the help of an adult, cut out Llama's shape.
- · Glue on a cotton ball for Llama's tail and let it dry.






