WE'LL NEED TO BORROW A BOAT . . .

3 Milk Carton Boat Craft &

Supplies:

- 1 clean, empty, cardboard milk carton
- Duct tape, or other waterproof tape
- Construction paper
- Drinking straws
- Hole puncher
- Scissors and a grown up to help!

Directions:

- 1. Cut a rectangular side panel out of the empty milk carton. The open side will be facing *up* when carton is placed in the water.
- 2. Cover the outside of the milk carton in duct tape or other waterproof tape.
- 3. Using scissors, cut a piece of construction paper into fourths. These will be your "sails"!
- 4. Decorate the sails with markers, crayons, or paint.
- 5. Punch holes in top and bottom of 2 of the sails.
- 6. Thread the drinking straws through the paper. The straws will be your "masts"!
- 7. Tape the masts to the inside of milk carton.
- 8. Place your boat in water and watch it float!

& Magnetic Fish and Fishing Pole Craft &


This craft contains small parts that may be a choking hazard and is best for readers aged 3 and up.

Supplies:

- Twine
- Wooden dowels or sticks
- Construction paper
- Markers, crayons, or paint
- · Paper clips
- Small magnets
- Scissors and a grown-up to help!

Directions:

- 1. Use the fish template to cut fish out of construction paper.
- 2. Decorate the fish, and be sure to give them names! Every fish deserves a proper name.
- 3. Clip a paper—clip to each fish.
- 4. Tie one end of the twine to one end of a stick or dowel.
- 5. Attach the magnet to the other end of the twine. This will be your "bait."
- 6. Place the fish in a baby pool, on a patch of blue construction paper, or just on an area of the rug! Feel free to get creative.
- 7. Go fishing!


