



COME FOR GAMES, TREATS, AND FUN!



A party isn't a party without a yummy cake! Ask a grown-up to help you follow this recipe to make a cake fit for Georgie and his friends!

GEORGIE'S CAKE RECIPE

INGREDIENTS:

- 3 cups flour (to make these gluten free, use gluten-free all-purpose flour, almond flour, or coconut flour)
- 1¾ cups sugar
- ½ tsp. baking powder
- ½ tsp. baking soda
- 1 tsp. salt
- 1 cup butter
- 4 eggs
- 1 cup buttermilk
- 2 tsp. vanilla extract



INSTRUCTIONS:

Ask a grown-up to preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Line cupcake pans with standard liners. Combine dry ingredients in a large bowl. Lightly whisk eggs in a medium bowl. Add remaining ingredients and stir together until blended. Add wet ingredients to dry ingredients, mixing well until completely combined. Separate batter into three greased 9-inch round pans. Bake for about 20 minutes or until a toothpick comes out clean when inserted. Let cool for 10 minutes before removing from pan; cool completely on a wire rack.


BUTTERCREAM FROSTING

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 cups butter, softened
- 1 tsp. vanilla extract
- 4-5 cups powdered sugar

INSTRUCTIONS:

Beat together: 2 cups butter, softened 1 tsp. vanilla extract. Fold in 4-5 cups of powdered sugar in batches, scraping down the sides of the bowl between each batch. Stack the three round cakes with frosting in between each layer, and frost the top and outside generously!





CAKE TOPPERS

Decorate your cake with these fun cake toppers! Just cut out the shapes, tape them to toothpicks, and place one in each cupcake. Now you're ready to party!



MAKE YOUR OWN PARTY HAT!


Get ready to party with a fun party hat! Simply follow the directions below, and you'll be looking festive in no time.

MATERIALS:

- Hat template
- Heavy paper (like poster board or cardstock)
- Ribbon
- Pencil
- Markers, glitter, puff balls, crepe paper . . . whatever decorations strike your fancy!
- Scissors, and a grown-up to help

DIRECTIONS:

- Step 1: Print, have a grown-up help cut out the template and trace it onto the heavy paper.
- Step 2: Have a grown-up help cut out the traced party hat.
- Step 3: Decorate your party hat with markers or crayons! Tip: It will be easier to draw on your hat now before you assemble it, but if you're gluing on decorations wait until after the hat is assembled.
- Step 4: Put the tab into the slot.
- Step 5: Glue on any additional decorations.
- Step 6: On each side of the hat, have a grown-up make small holes with the scissors.
- Step 7: Push the ribbon through each hole and tie a knot to hold it.
- Step 8: PARTY!





PIN THE TAIL ON LESTER GAME

MATERIALS:

• Scissors, and a grown-up to help • Tape • Blindfold

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Step 1: Print and find a grown-up to help cut out the picture of Lester, and as many tails as you need.
 - Step 2: Have each party-goer write their initials on one tail.
 - Step 3: Tape the picture of Lester to the wall.
 - Step 4: Put a small piece of tape on the end of each tail.
- Step 5: Blindfold each guest, and have them try to pin the tail on Lester! Whoever gets closest wins!






PIN THE TAIL ON LESTER GAME















Where's the PARTH MAZE


Help Georgie find his friends and the party by tracing the correct path.
