Make Your Own Dog Tags!

Follow these easy steps to make dog name tags with the kids using these supplies.


- Doggo and Pupper cutout
- Scissors
- Construction paper
- Glue or glue stick
- Hole punch
- A long piece of ribbon

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Choose your favorite character. Are you old Doggo or young Pupper?
- 2. Using safety scissors and with the help of an adult, cut out the dog tag and a piece of construction paper that's the same size.
- 3. Glue the cutout to the construction paper for support.
- 4. With the help of a parent, use the hole punch to place a hole at the top.
- 5. Thread the ribbon through and tie a knot.
- 6. That's it! Now you have your very own Doggo or Pupper name tag.










Draw the Good Old Days!




Create Your Own Doggo or Pupper!




ABOUT THE AUTHOR
