SANDBOX BEERGARITAS

The women of LADIES' NIGHT, have been known to knock back a cocktail, especially a character named Ashleigh. Here's a slightly different twist on a margarita. Some consider it pretty tacky, others just consider it delish, but it's absolutely the kind of drink dive bar owner Rochelle would serve at The Sandbox, her Florida Gulf Coast beach bar. For the Fake-a-Rita Rochelle has been known to offer to customers who've had enough, just delete the beer and tequila. We'll never tell!

Ingredients:

1-12 oz. can frozen limeade
1-12-oz. can lemon-lime soda (like Sprite)
1-12 oz. bottle beer (go ahead and use
a Mexican beer like Corona)

12-oz. decent quality tequila
3 limes.
Ice
Kosher salt



Preparation:

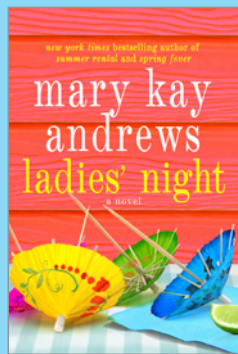
Fill pitcher halfway with ice. Dump in the partially thawed limeade. Fill empty limeade can with tequila and dump that in. Slowly add the beer—it'll foam up, so be patient or you'll have spillage. Add lemon-lime soda to taste—more or less depending on how sweet you like your cocktail. Squeeze two limes and add to pitcher. Use third lime to rub rims of glasses, then dip in salt—if you're the salty type. Bottoms up!
